A day in the life of communicating as a teenager:

Which electronic devices have you used to communicate and why?
An example could be your Xbox to chat to friends or your phone to text a relative.
What kind of message did you need to communicate?
An example could be you told your Alexa to set an alarm to wake you up, or that you texted a friend asking which bus they were getting
How did you make sure you did this clearly and safely?
An example could be you double checked you had the right number. You might text your friend to make sure it is them you are chatting to on Xbox. You may need to make sure that you only post safe images and comments - how would you do that?

A day in the life of communicating as an adult:



Which electronic devices have they used to communicate and why?
An example could be their laptop to email someone at work or their phone to text a relative.
What kind of message did they need to communicate?
An example could be they told your Alexa to announce your dinner was ready, or that they emailed school to check what homework you had. They may have had to email a document to someone or a photo!
How did they make sure you both did this clearly and safely?
An example could be you both double checked you had the right number. The adult may have parental controls on your account. The adult may give you advice on how to stay safe or may monitor some of your accounts. You may also give advice to them if they haven't used an app before!
