Dear Parents and Carers,

As the term moves on I am sure that many of you, and your children, are starting to consider purchasing school uniforms.

The full uniform policy can be found on the school website. Please [click here](#) to access the Year 7 Parent Handbook for 2021/22. I would recommend reading pages 6 - 9 before purchasing a uniform.

Our school uniform provider is Emblematic, please [click here](#) to access their website. Emblematic sells St Thomas More blazers, skirts and PE kits. Please ensure you order by **18th July at the latest** to ensure the uniform is delivered in time for September. From experience, I would strongly recommend ordering sooner rather than later. You can order online or in store.

School ties are available to purchase from the School Office from 8.30am - 4pm, Mon - Fri, during term time.

You may be aware that St Thomas More recently changed name from St Thomas More RC Academy, to St Thomas More Catholic High School. At St Thomas More we expect that some students will wear St Thomas More RC Academy branded uniform for at least a few years. This is natural as families and friends pass on uniforms. Emblematic has assured us that all blazers sold this year will have the new logo, however there may be a mixture of the old and new logo in the PE kits. Please do not worry if your child has a St Thomas More RC Academy uniform, we expect to see a number of students with this logo.

Points to note:

- School jumpers are an optional item, and most students rarely wear a school jumper as they have a school blazer which must always be worn. Therefore, I would suggest not purchasing a school jumper unless you think your child will definitely wear it.
- Emblematic are not currently open on weekends, only Mon - Fri. We know that from June they will open on Saturdays but we do not have a specific date.
- School skirts must not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- School trousers should be mid-grey, traditional tailored trousers (for both boys and girls).
- All students must wear plain black, traditional school shoes. Please see the uniform policy for specific examples.
